We had a very enjoyable day in Birr rugby club for our tag rugby blitz. The pupils had a fun filled day and finished the day with some lovely hotdogs.

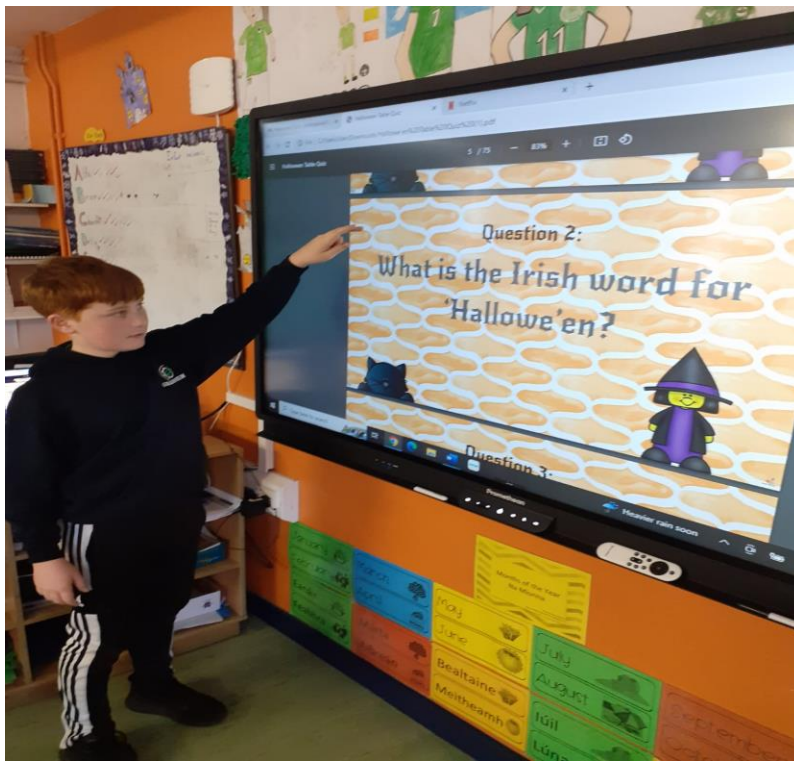


ICT Upgrades
